Re: Correction Statement on October 7, 2014 News Article


Dear Attorney Millis:

As counsel for Trempealeau County concerning this matter, please accept this as a correction statement regarding the October 7, 2014 news article.

On October 7, 2014 an article entitled “Wisconsin County Shuts Down Frac-Sand Operation ‘Running Wild’” was published. The article quoted Kevin Lien, the Director of the Trempealeau County Department of Land Management, and stated that Superior Silica Sands, LLC was operating the mine site referred to in the article as “The Guza Pit.” The news article is inaccurate. The required reclamation permit holder of the mine site is Cameron Rail, LLC, not Superior Silica Sands, LLC.

At this time, there is no reason to conclude Superior Silica Sands, LLC was operating the mine site without the required permits, was responsible for the storage of chemicals in a pond without a concrete liner or was responsible for the release of any polluted wastewater as stated in the article referenced above. Trempealeau County intends to continue with its investigation of the compliance issues at the Guza Pit.
